Report:

College, Berinag, organized a Poster Competition on the theme "Research and Innovation" on 07 August 2026. The activity was conducted with the objective of fostering scientific temperament, creativity, critical thinking, and an innovation-driven mind set among undergraduate students while encouraging them to express their ideas through visual presentation. The competition aligns with the ABSS-2026 emphasis on promoting research and innovation as key components of higher education.

The programme was organized under the chairmanship of Dr. Mahesh Chandra Pandey, Officiating Principal, Government P.G. College, Berinag. 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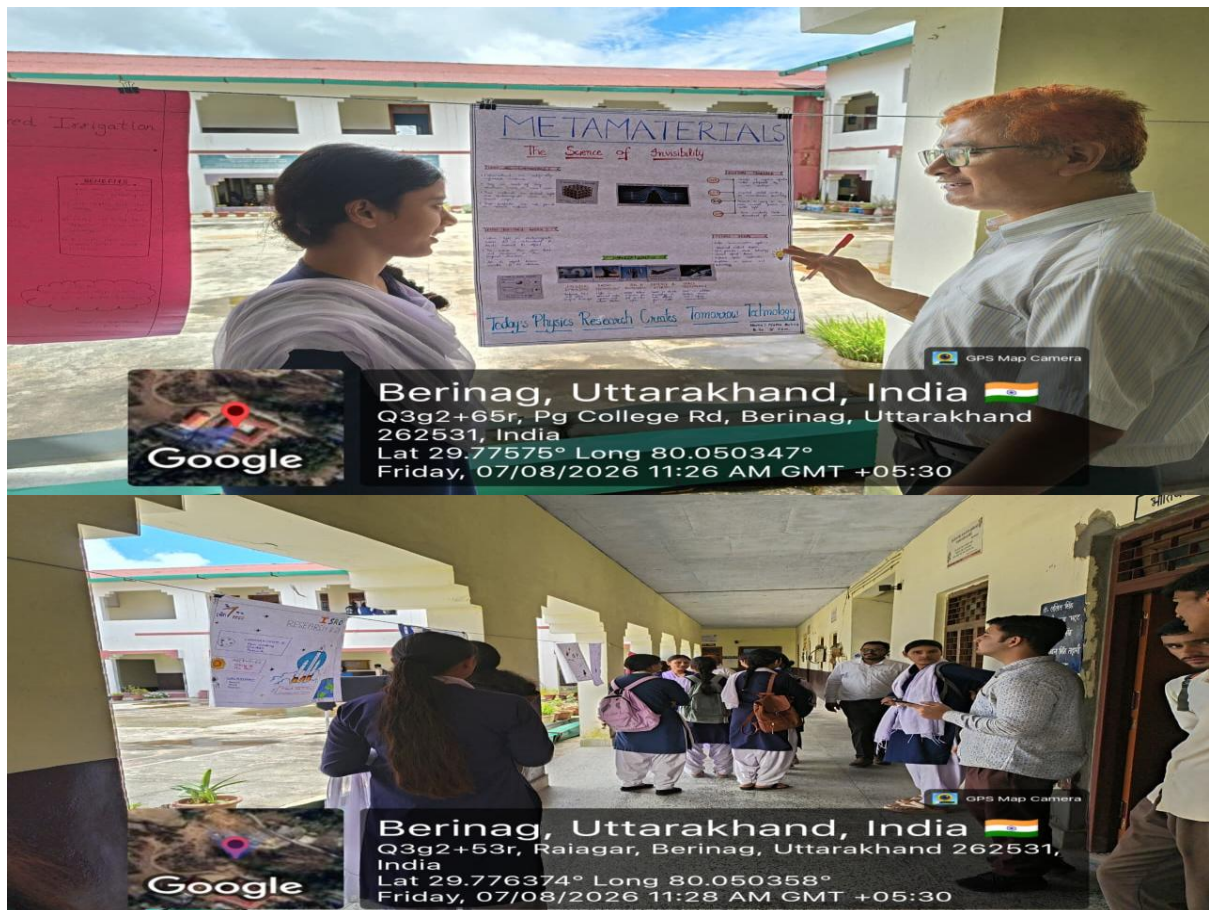
