Code of Ethics to Check Malpractices and Plagiarism in Research

Ethics is the most significant element of the academic activities in teaching and research. Teaching and research is always subject to the transfer of knowledge and provides freedom to express the knowledge. In the academic process this freedom to invent and express knowledge is always confined to the ethics. Research provides freedom to inquire for innovation of new things in subject that encourages intellectual concern, to present findings, to publish data and conclusions. Integrity is required between teaching and all these components of research. But while presenting the innovation, data or thoughts the ethics in academic process should not be violated.

Although the general consensus is that plagiarism is a bad idea, it can be difficult to avoid it or discuss it if we have different understandings of the definition:

- To steal and pass off (the ideas or words of another) as one's own;
- To use (another's production) without crediting the source;
- To commit literary theft;
- To present as new and original an idea or product derived from an existing source.

The purpose of the Regulations and Code of Ethics for Research Degree Programmes is to maintain the quality and academic standards of the research degrees and to provide regulatory information and guidance for Research Scholars and other Teaching Staff.

1. Authors must ensure that they have written original works. In addition, they must ensure that their manuscript has not been issued anywhere else.
2. Any work or words of other authors or contributors should be appropriately credited and referenced.
3. Authors are also responsible for language editing before submitting the article. Authors submitting their work to journal or publication as original articles must confirm that the submitted work represents their contribution and has not been copied in whole or in parts without clearly citing. Any work or words of other authors, contributors or sources (including online sites) should be appropriately credited and referenced.
