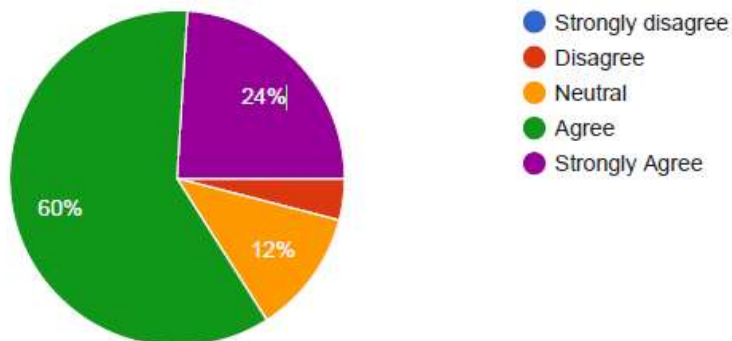

1. College Provides all Class room Physical facilities.

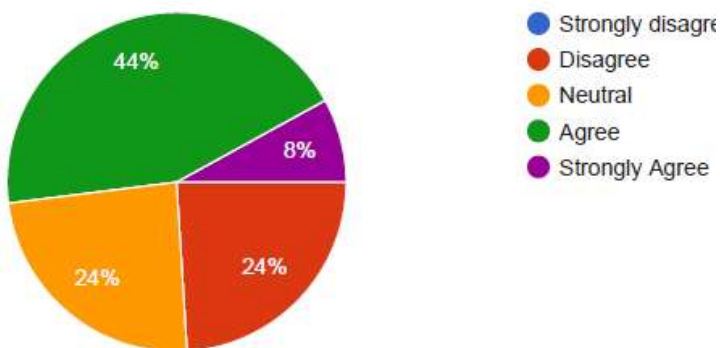
25 responses

2. College Provides ICT facilities for class room teaching.

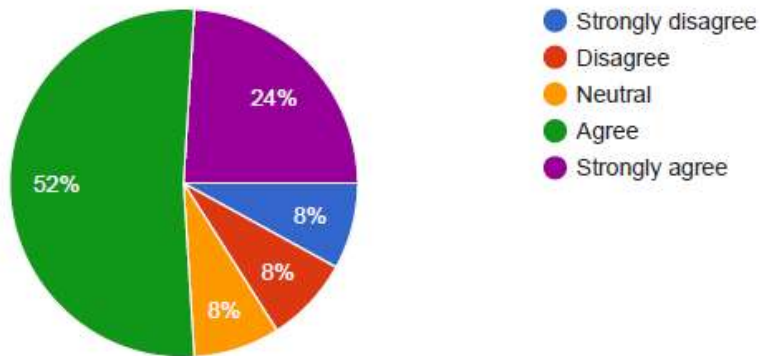
25 responses

3. College provides opportunities for continuous development of Staff .

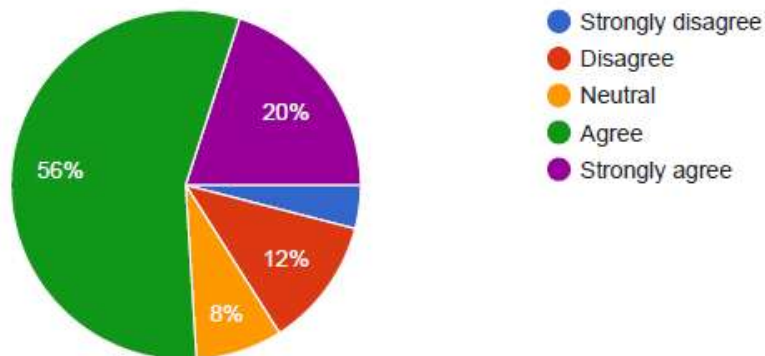
25 responses

4.Equal opportunities for all staff is provided

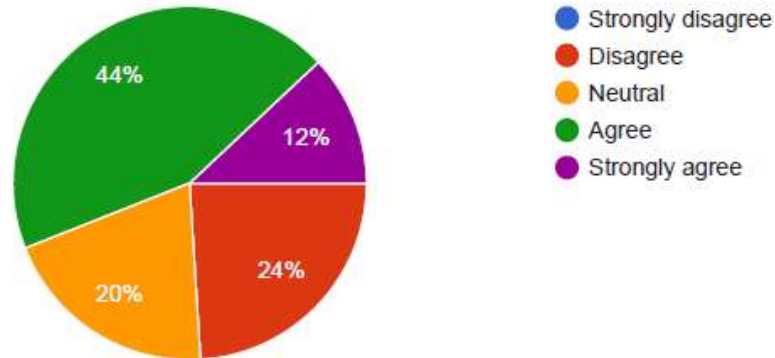
25 responses

5. Laboratory requirements including equipments, chemicals and specimens are regularly provided by the college.

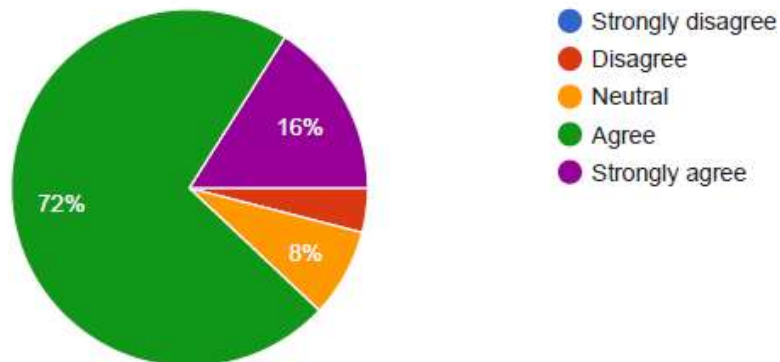

6. Capabilities/ Potential of the staff are fully utilized.

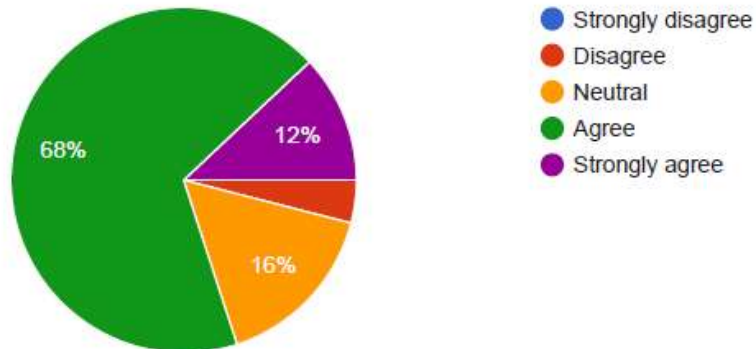
25 responses

7. Recognition/ Incentive/ Appreciation of the individual work is given .

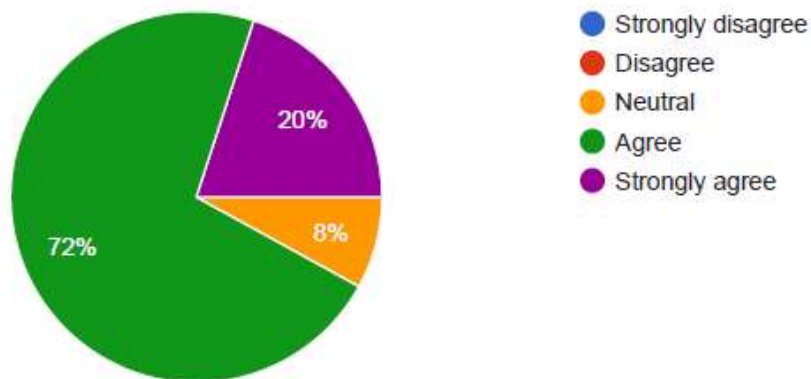
25 responses

8. Students are disciplined and respect the Staff members

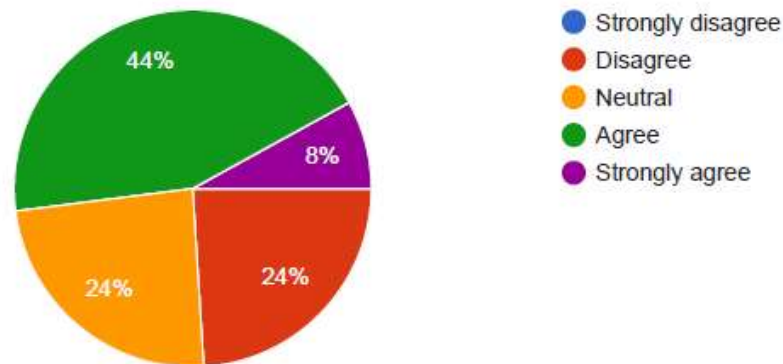
25 responses
