- 3- On May 7, 2019, A career counselling programme was organised in collaboration with USERC (Uttarakhand Science Education & Research Centre, Dehradun, Uttarakhand) in which Prof. Rajkumar S Pant from IIT Mumbai, Maharashtra, Prof. Durgesh Pant Director USERC and Prof. B.D. Lakhchaura (Retired Professor and Head, Department of Biotechnology, G. B. Pant University) delivered their lecture among students and motivated the students through their lectures.
- 4- To make students more knowledgeable in science, Science Outreach Programme was organised by HGVS Institute. Many students of the college participated actively in this programme and were encouraged by the members of HGVS Institute.
- 5- To develop skill and creativity among students, value added course was organised from May 1 to May 15 by all the departments. In this programme, all the faculty members prepared their syllabus of different courses and completed their syllabus during scheduled time. After completion of the course, certificates were awarded to

those students who successfully completed their courses. 110 students were enrolled in this certificate course.

- 1- At first, the agenda passed in the previous meeting, was reviewed by all the members of the committee and discussed about the progress of its actions.
- 2- To develop skill, creativity among students for the interest of students, pre-admission counselling programme was organised in the college on 05-07-19. Total 107 students participated in this programme. They were told about the values of different subjects.
- 3- A seminar on gender discrimination towards women was organised in the college to decrease harassment relating to gender discrimination on 22-08-2019. Decisions/Actions:

1. For opposing the use of narcotics and other drugs, on 8 November 2019 an anti-drug club was formed in the college. To make students aware of the prohibition of Narcotics and other drugs, Guardians and students were also included in this club.
2. In this sequence, on 13 November under the convenor ship of the principal Prof. C.D. Suntha, an anti-drug clinic was established. For proper functioning of this clinic 10 students and 10 guardians were involved in this clinic.
3. On 15 November 2019 a one-day seminar on Quality up-gradation and Innovation in Higher Education was organised. In the college the chief guest of this seminar was Dr. Kuldeep Singh Negi, Deputy Director of Higher Education Uttarakhand. In his motivational lecture Dr. Negi highlighted the methods and techniques of quality up-gradation and innovations in higher education. The seminar was presided over by Prof. C.D. Suntha, Principal.
4. To provide equal opportunity to students belonging to oppressed and deprived section of society, on 19 November 2019 an equal opportunity cell was formed. The purpose of this cell was to provide equal opportunities without any partiality or biasness.

5. For the self-protection of girl students, one day seminar on self-defence in collaboration with local police was organised on 26 December 2019. In this programme police sub-inspector, Miss Kanchan Gaira threw reflections on self defence mechanism particularly for women students.
