Department of mathematics showed a tremendous improvement in comparison to performance in the last session. They also need to improve upon their efforts to integrate their subject with real world problems.

Department of physics is also excellent or very good as far as perception of the student is concerned.

English, Sanskrit, Sociology, Economics, Hind, leave much scope for improvement. Among humanities Political Science, History faired a little better. The performance of the teachers of Geography is also excellent.

The performance of entire B.Ed. department is commendable.
