About the College

Government Post Graduate College Berinag is located in a small semi urban hill township, called Berinag, in district Pithoragarh of Uttarakhand state. It is at a distance of 90 Km from the district headquarter and 196 Km from the nearest rail head, Kathgodam Haldwani. Although being situated in remote border area, it abounds in beauty of the nature with plenty of forest cover, rich flora and fauna and faces snow capped Panchachuli and Nanda Devi peaks of the Himalaya. Established in the year 1975, in the then state of Uttar Pradesh, with the purpose of providing opportunities of higher education in an unserved remote border area, it start-ed as a degree college, offering courses at under graduate level in languages and humanities, with affiliation to Kumaun University. In 1979, sciences courses were started in Physic, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany and Mathematics at under graduate level. In the year 1989, it got recognition of the U G C under section 2(f) and 12(B). From this small beginning, it flourished to a post graduate college in the year 2003 offering PG courses in four science and five language/ humanities subjects. Another milestone was reached in 2004 when Government P G College, Berinag, in first cycle, got B+ Accreditation from NAAC. It further strengthened in the year 2008 with the introduction of B. Ed. course under self-financed mode. In the year 2014, college signed an MOU with Uttarakhand Open University and started many courses under the distance Education mode. In the year 2019, college got B grade Accreditation from NAAC in second cycle.

About the Seminar:

India is the country with the second largest population in the world and its biggest feature is that a large part of this population is the youth population, providing employment to which is the biggest challenge for the country. With the resolution to connect the country's youth with employment and to make a self-reliant India, the Government of India is helping to start self-employment and entrepreneurship through various schemes. Keynote Address by Dr. Sunil Pande, NIDHI

Dr. Sunil Pande, Secretary NIDHI delivered an illuminating Keynote address on promoting Women Empowerment Through SHG's, Rural development, Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development , Education and Science Popularization, Formation of FPO, Water and sanitation (Jal Jeevan Mission) Tribal Development Fund (TDF). NIDHI is working in 4 Districts of Uttarakhand : Pithoragarh , Champawat and Almora , Nainital. Project undertaken/ being undertaken with the Support of Varius Agency: FPO Formation , Jal Jeevan Mission, TDF (Tribal Development Project), SHG Formation , Farmer Club Formation , MEDP (Micro enterprises development Programme), LEDP(Livelihood & enterprise development Programme), Skill Development Program- Training, Capacity Building – For SHG members, E.D.P. ,Technology Transformation in agriculture Sec., Awareness Program, Science Popularization, Sector Program, T.S.C. NCSC & Training Program Exposure & Study ,Water and Sanitation Programme.





Address by Speaker Vinod Karki, Founder, Berinag Tea

It is an autonomous cooperative firm where they plant plants, Develop farms and buy tea leaf from small farmers. In the initial phases, they hire skilled workers from assam and got locals trained in the art. They provide skill training to 7 workers which are permanent and 10 workers work on daily basis @ Rs.

400 per day. Today they have total 17 workers from nearby areas who work permanently in the garden and plant. They have total land of 8.7 hectares. They have converted over 5 hectare of barren lands into green tea plantation. Generated the source of employment both permanent as well as on daily wages. They also buy regularly tea bud saplings from other farmers at a competitive rate helping them in sustaining their business. They also gave guidance to nearby villages about tea plantation and donated 1500 saplings. Also Berinag Tea is under GI tag (geographical).

They told that all process from production to packaging is done near our farms using the old orthodox method which maintains its taste and aroma for long time. Berinag tea produces less color and no additional preservatives are used, finally its pure organic tea at your cup.

Unique value proposition: Freshness and natural aroma closely monitored process; handwork, hardwork, minimal machine use.

For self Dependence for long term Sustainability : They have their own nursery.

First Technical Session

After High tea the first technical session began. The chairperson of the technical session was Prof. C. D. Suntha, GPGC college Berinag, Dr. Garima Punetha, Assistant Professor Physics, GPGC Berinag. The first presentation was given by Rajinder Singh Bisht, who is director of an NGO called Himalayan Gram Vikas Samiti (HGVS) at Dashainthal, near Gangolihat, Pithoragarh District, in India's northern state of Uttarakhand. Himalayan Gram Vikas Samiti is an organisation that focuses on implementing social programs in Gangolihat and its nearby areas. This organisation takes up the socio-economic problem and with a team of well-appointed trained staff, and try to solve these problems. These problems include education, water, sanitation, hygiene, safety issues and many more.



He elaborated project activities and description of work undertaken.

Baseline survey: Village level meetings (5) were conducted for awareness creation and repo-building in which 118 villagers participated. Coordination Meeting (02) in the Gram Panchayat were organized in which 119 community representatives participated. Gram Panchayat Meeting (01) conducted to pass the proposals of different convergence activities in which 25 community representatives participated. Heath Awareness Workshop (01) in the gram panchayat were Organised in which 64 community person participated. International women's day celebrated (01) in Village Level in which 33 womens participated.

Training on strengthening of SHGs: One SHG Formed in Pokhari Project Village. One Adpoted SHG desolved in Choki Village. A total of 12 SHGs were taken under the project for strengthening and activities. Leadership development and book keeping –Training (01) were conducted for SHG members attended by 25 participants. Training on Vegetable Production (01) was conducted in conversance with GHCL Foundation Trust Gujarat at HGVS Office Gangolihat for SHG members attended by 11 participants.

Management & business promotion: A SHG cluster federation was developed and letter on registered as Nauling Swayatt Sahakarita constituting 189 members having a Board of Directors of 12 members. Orientation Workshops (02) for members and Board of Directors of Cooperative were organised to impart training and skill to run the Cooperative and dairy business. A total of 110 members and officer bearers attended the workshops. Monthly meetings of Self Reliant Cooperative (11) including AGM (01) was convened. Networking and linkage agreement was signed by the Nauling SRC with Kamdhenu SRC, Gangolihat to run their dairy under the brand name of Kamdhenu.

Dairy development: Improved mulch animals were purchased by 37 livestock farmers. 27 farmers reformed their cattle shed and 15 constructed animal troughs for better utilization of fodder by animals. Cluster federation established a dairy shop at cluster level and 85 farmers had been associated with the dairy enterprise. Milk collection was reached up to 70-85 litter per day and the dairy had a turnover of Rs 584372/-during the year and Rs 526136/- was paid to the contributors. All necessary dairy equipments, utensils and office equipments had been procured. Animal health camp (01) was organised at Pokhari village in which 28 beneficiaries got consultancy and medicines for their animals. Ten animals were insured under AH departmental schemes. Mineral mixture, calcium and dewormer were also distributed during the camps. Exposure Visit/Livestock and dairy Business Trainings (01) was organised at GBPUAT, Pantnagar for livestock farmers attendant by 31 participants. Livestock and Animal Health Trainings (01) Conducted in HGVS Office Gangolihat For livestock farmers attendant by 18 participants.

The presentation was given by Sri Ratnakar Pandey, SHEG in which he elaborated the work done by SHEG during Covid Period.



Swasthya Pahad started as an initiative for covid relief work, covering 750+ villages in remote areas across hill districts of Uttarakhand, with accumulative population of more than a million people, mostly women and children. In this direction, Askot, a remote town on Indo- Nepal Border of Pithoragarh district has a significant tribal population. They are known in locality as Van Rawats or Raji or Kirat. A primary health centre in extremely dilapidated condition is the only medical facility that they have there. We Chose Project Swasthya Pahad in first place with the help of progressive organisations like ARPAN, YUWA and RAHWASI in addition to few individuals who were trying to mobilise resources for fighting pandemic there. There were cases, where some of members helped us to connect with other NGO's and coordinate to deliver specific items to beneficiaries in various villages and who walked that extra mile and helped us in this initiative.

1. Medical Oxygen for all provided 10 no's, 5LPM oxygen concentrators to Army Covid care facility set up at Berinag.
2. SHAKTI provided one 5 LPM Oxygen concentrators to Women Hospital, Pithoragarh.
3. SHAKTI also donated 100 Oximeters, 100 Thermometers, 7500 cloth masks, 5000 triple layer masks, 100 face shields, 12500 nonsurgical gloves, 100 shoulder bag and 100 sanitizer (0.5 litres).
4. SEWA International provided customized Asha Health worker kits and 240 health and hygiene kits for distribution in 12 remote villages of champawat district in Nepal Border.
